BRTT contrib goals

- Provide enhanced functionality to users
- Encourage community-building
- Venue for users to meet parochial/esoteric needs



BRTT contrib goals

- Laissez-faire approach from BRTT
 - We don't want to touch it
 - Tell us what branch to pull from for devel/release
 - Reserving right to exceptions for things we've written or put in ourselves
- Clear engineering distinction between contrib and commercial
 - witness xpls, smartpick, localmake problems



BRTT contrib policies

What we need in each contrib submission:

- Man page with name, synopsis, author specified
- Antelopemake-compatible Makefile
- Explicit license with distribution terms *NEW
 - e.g. BSD, MIT
 - not distributing GPL, LGPL
 - See http://opensource.org/licenses
 - not all open-source licenses are created equal



New ANTELOPEMAKE extension mechanism

- Keep using
 - include \$ANTELOPEMAKE
- If:
 - SUBDIR is specified e.g. SUBDIR=/contrib
 - there exists\$(ANTELOPE)\$(SUBDIR)/include/antelopemakerules
- Then \$(ANTELOPEMAKE) will include it
