rtgit

- Coupling of real-time systems with *git* content tracking
- Track Antelope real-time system configuration
 - Core debugging question: "What Changed??"
 - Help solve the "Nothing Changed" puzzle
- Rapidly redeploy systems on new machines
- Track stable and semi-stable files; don't track "outputs" or "state"



rtgit subcommands

- rtgit init
 - executed from within rtexec(1) run directory
 - Zeroth-order setup
- rtgit autoupdate
 - Automatically run rtgit periodically
- rtgit diffsince
- rtgit tarball
- Standard git commands in the run directory
